

Examination System

The examination is a combination of Continuous Internal Assessment and Term- end Examinations.

Continuous Internal Assessment

Internal evaluation is 40% and Term-End examination is of 60 % weightage. 50% of Internal assessment i.e. 20% of overall assessment is through Mid-Term Test and rest 20% of internal assessment have components like

Project work , Presentations and Viva-Voce

Quiz, etc.

The internal assessment marks awarded shall be notified by the concerned faculty. Students who fail to meet the deadlines for submission of project or assignment or who absent themselves at Internal Assessment sessions shall not be entitled to any credits assigned for the same.

End- Term Examination

The two year program comprises five Term-End examinations as notified in the academic calendar of the Institution.
